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**ARCHWAY COMMUNITIES HOSTS GRAND OPENING OF ROBINSON PLACE**

*The Lakewood project boasts 67 affordable housing units for seniors ages 62+*

**LAKEWOOD, Colo. (Oct. 5, 2023)** - Today, Archway Communities (Archway) hosted the grand opening of Robinson Place, a three-story, low-rise apartment complex in Lakewood. This project represents 67 one-bedroom and two-bedroom affordable housing units reserved for older adults ages 62 and up. Residents began moving into their new apartments in early Sept.

“Archway is committed to working with local communities throughout Colorado to help provide greater access to affordable housing. We are incredibly grateful for the support we had on Robinson Place from the City of Lakewood, JeffCo, Colorado Housing Finance Agency, and the Colorado Division of Housing,” said Sebastian Corradino, Archway’s CEO. “The Robinson Place Community is a great example of how working with committed partners, we can help all Coloradans live their best life.”

The Robinson Place community comprises 59 one-bedroom and eight two-bedroom units, 85% of units are at or below 50% Area Median Income (AMI) and it also offers 15 [HUD-VASH](#) units for formerly homeless veterans aged 62+. The non-smoking campus community offers community spaces, it features a full-time onsite supportive service coordinator along with a property manager and a maintenance technician and certain units are ADA compatible. The project received nine percent Low-Income Housing Tax Credit (LIHTC). At this time all units are called for, but there is a waiting list for interested parties.

“We are thrilled about the opening of Archway’s Robinson Place,” said Adam Paul, Mayor of Lakewood. “Affordable housing is essential and this new community provides a place for our older neighbors who may want to downsize from a bigger house to a smaller place in an affordable way. They can remain in the community where they want to live.”

Archway currently operates 9 properties and over 1,200 residents are served every year across the Denver metro area and in Colorado Springs.
